Instead of playing only three hours as scheduled, entertainers [Jim] and Tim played for seven and a half hours at the beer garden, according to Al Lee, Lions Club treasurer and beer garden manager.

'Even though most of us were wet and muddy, we had fun,' Lee said. 'A lot of my friends said it was the best Elburn Days ever."

A seven and a half hour first gig. That pretty much sealed the deal. You see, the crowd got larger as the day went on and they wanted Jim & Tim to keep playing.
